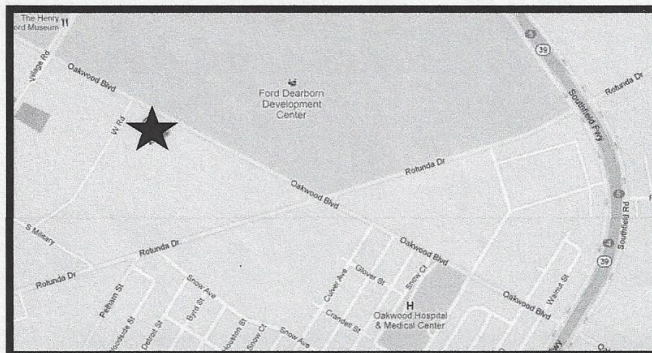
# **Kick-Off Dinner Celebrating 70 Years**

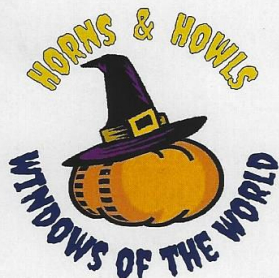
