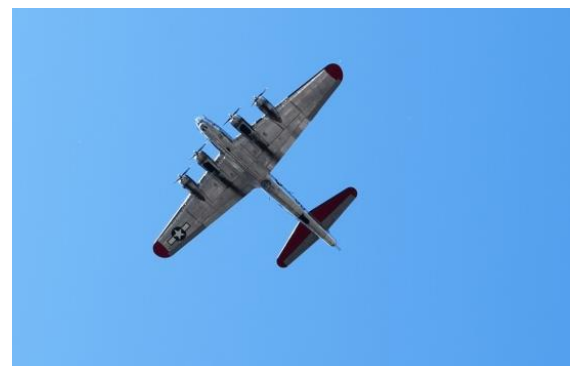
It's OK to talk to yourself...and ok to answer yourself. But sad when you have to repeat what you said because you weren't listening!!
