He explained the District Court handles all misdemeanors, traffic tickets, landlord-tenant disputes, civil suits up to \$25,000 and small claims court (up to \$5k000 where no attorneys are present). The Wayne County Circuit Court handles civil cases over \$25,000, felonies, murders, personal protection orders and criminal cases. Next is the Court of Appeals which examines the transcripts of the previous judge adjudicated trials. This consists of a three-judge panel and they submit their opinion. If you disagree, uou submit an appeal to the Supreme Court, which is the highest court in Michigan and essentially the last stop.

First V.P Mike presented our speaker with a laser pen and the guest picked out the winning ticket. Ray Scobroia suggested our speaker and his opponent Judge Somers appear on Kiwani Talk.
