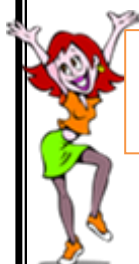

Entrance to the Large Shelter is on Cherry Hill, top of the Hill. The restrooms are not as convenient but they are close by and newly renovated.

Legally, we don't have to move, but the "Dearborn Specials" were under the assumption they had the small shelter on the same day and it's been on their calendar which has been widely distributed to 250+ disabled adults and caregivers in our Community!

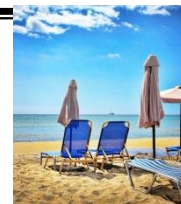
**Al** fined **Renea** for having marijuana leaves on her pants.
