MI District Foundation Raffle

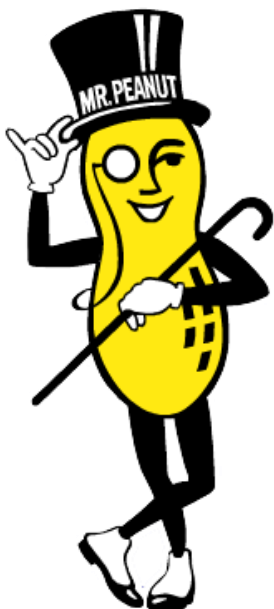

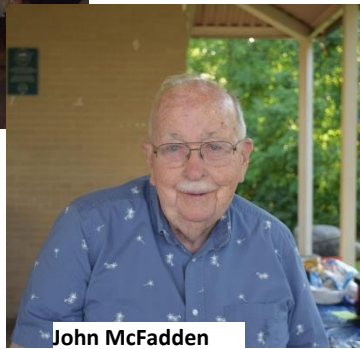

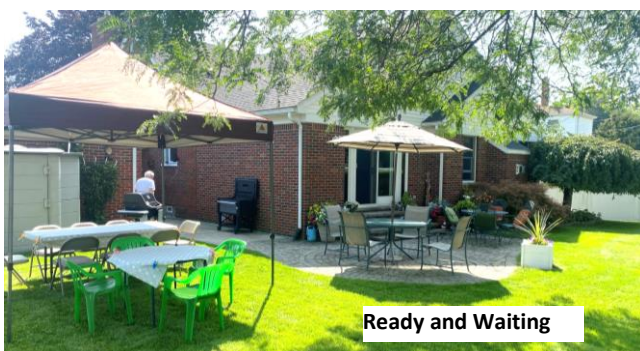
